

Together We Build

During the 2016-17 fiscal year, the Habitat family came together to build and dedicate its 460th home. During Habitat’s 33 years of existence, more than 500 adults and 770 children have experienced the strength, stability and self-reliance that comes with Habitat homeownership! Through our tithe, we have also served another 370 international families. As Habitat supporters, we all know that the impact of our work is much more than the floors, walls and roofs that surround our families. Through our hand-up partnership, Habitat families realize their power to build a better future for themselves and their children. Their hard work, determination and perseverance is at the very core of the Habitat ministry.

In this annual report, you will see many examples of the transformation that takes place because of your generosity. We were blessed to assist 13 families gain access to decent and affordable shelter in Mt. Vernon and in the Jacobsville Neighborhood of Evansville this past fiscal year. We continue to grow that number as we have 15 homes under construction in the Glenwood and Howell Neighborhoods, 31 families working to complete their sweat equity hours and have already closed on 5 homes since the end of the 2016-17 fiscal year. Further evidence of the transformation that takes place can be found in the Impact Study which was completed in 2016. It showed that Habitat homeowners feel better about themselves, are engaged in their neighborhoods, save money for the future, and significantly reduce their dependence on government assistance programs. The children of Habitat homeowners are more likely to graduate from high school. Homeownership provides a strong and stable foundation upon which individuals and families can thrive and build a brighter tomorrow.

Habitat’s mission of building homes, community and hope not only builds stronger families, it also strengthens our community. Volunteers are provided the opportunity to develop life-long friendships, and donors feel secure in knowing their gifts are being put to good use and making a difference. Every member of our Habitat family, from homeowners to donors to volunteers, is integral to the success of our mission. Giving back and getting involved are keys to creating the transformational, impactful change that occurs through Habitat’s important work.

As Habitat for Humanity supporters, we all see the need for a world where everyone has a decent, affordable place to live. We invite you to help us build that world! While we are looking forward to dedicating our 500th home soon, our work will not stop there. The need is great and with God’s guidance and blessing and your support, we will rise to meet that need – one Habitat family at a time.

In the spring of 2016, Habitat for Humanity of Evansville partnered with Diehl Consulting Group to implement a broad evaluation of the organization's impact. Based on the research we know that...

97% of Habitat homes are in sound condition and good repair.



Neighbors would like to see more Habitat homes in their community.

The high school graduation rate among children living in Habitat homes exceeded the official graduation rates for local public schools.

41.7% of Habitat homeowners reported that they or someone else in their family had started or completed higher education or training since owning their homes.

Habitat homeowners are less dependent on government assistance programs.





Although not open to the public until August of 2017, the Habitat for Humanity of Evansville ReStore, LLC was well under way during the 2017 fiscal year. Many obstacles were tackled including: planning by the ReStore Advisory Committee, hiring and training of the ReStore team, acquiring item donations, selecting the store location, and renovating the building. Many volunteer hours went into the opening of the Habitat ReStore in Evansville, and to everyone who helped make this ReStore possible ... we want to say THANK YOU!

The purpose of Habitat for Humanity of Evansville's ReStore is to help provide funding for our organization's mission of bringing people together to build homes, communities and hope. The store does this by selling donated new and gently used appliances, furniture, cabinets, building materials and household items to the general public.

By providing a free pick-up service, the store is also an outlet for our donors to be able to recycle and repurpose items that may have otherwise gone to our local landfills. Since these items are donated to us, we are able to provide our donors with a charitable gift receipt.


