We had many things to celebrate in Fiscal Year 2024!

- We dedicated our **600th home**, becoming only the 25th Habitat affiliate in the nation to reach that milestone.
- **24 families**, including **26 adults and 40 children**, received the keys to their new homes last year.
- We built **33 new homes** in Tepe Park, which is **9** more than our original plan.
- We launched a new plan to build at least **33 new homes** in the CHAIN neighborhood. (Cedar Hall Association for Improvement of the Neighborhood)
- We maintained a **4-star rating on Charity Navigator and a Platinum Rating on GuideStar**, which are the highest ratings an organization can achieve.
- **678 volunteers donated 32,766 hours** building homes, mentoring families, folding letters, and more. The value of their donated time was **more than \$900,000!**

Because of God’s guidance and provision and you, our faithful supporters, I’m choosing not to worry. Instead, I’m rejoicing and looking forward to serving more families than we have ever served before! The future is bright and full of possibilities! I know the lives of the 150 families that will be served by Habitat over the next five years will be forever changed by your generosity and kindness. 



40 Years of Building

In April 2024, Habitat for Humanity of Evansville celebrated 40 years as an organization. Since its founding, over 600 families now have a safe and affordable place to call home, an accomplishment that not even our founders could have imagined was possible. What started with a four-bedroom home at the corner of Cross and Governor streets and only a few volunteers, has grown into a community-wide endeavor that spans over a dozen neighborhoods in Vanderburgh and Posey Counties. Hundreds of volunteers have devoted their time to work alongside Habitat families on the build site and countless more organizations, businesses and individuals have joined these efforts to provide financial support and sponsorships to make these homes possible. We extend our heartfelt gratitude to everyone who has partnered with Habitat over the years to help families in need achieve their dream of homeownership!



North Posey and Mt. Vernon

Although most homes built by Habitat for Humanity of Evansville are in Vanderburgh County, families in Posey County will continue to be a focus of ours in the years to come. After building 17 homes in Mt. Vernon and 1 in Poseyville, we recently dedicated our first home in Cynthiana. This project is the direct result of residents and the faith community in northern Posey County coming together to raise funds and help families in need of affordable and stable housing. We are excited to continue working with this wonderful community and are excited to build even more homes.



Aging in Place

Habitat for Humanity of Evansville is blessed to partner with many different organizations that provide volunteers and the funding needed to build a home. This past year, Habitat teamed up with AARP Indiana to help Louise D. care for her bedridden brother, Jack, and allow the two of them to age in place in their new Habitat home. The home was ADA-compliant and included a walk-in shower and entrance ramp. After the home dedication, AARP Indiana returned several months later to visit Jack and Louise and see how their lives have changed since moving into their Habitat home. We are grateful to everyone at AARP Indiana for their support of Jack and Louise and Habitat's mission.



We Build the Home and You Take the Credit

An exciting new opportunity for Habitat donors arrived this past year – the Attainable Homeownership Tax Credit! Our state Habitat organization has been advocating for this credit for several years for the purpose of building more affordable homes for low-income families throughout the state. Thankfully, the tax credit was adopted in the state's 2024 budget and will be in place for 2025 also.

The tax credit allows individuals and businesses who pay Indiana state taxes to receive a 50% tax credit for their donations to Habitat. Essentially, this means you can double your donation and have the same financial outcome. The Evansville affiliate was awarded \$650,000 in tax credits which will generate \$1,300,000 in contributions. There are a limited number of credits, and they are available on a first-come, first-served basis. 

CORE CREW

The Core Crew is made up of men and women giving 80+ hours a year building Habitat homes. Groups volunteer on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and/or Saturdays from 7:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. doing a combination of jobs including building floor systems, raising walls, installing siding, completing interior work, and more. Becoming a Core Crew member doesn't require any construction experience and all skill levels are welcome.

The Core Crew is building homes from the ground up, and Habitat could not be more thankful for their dedication!

Millard Fuller (1935 – 2009) co-founded Habitat for Humanity International in 1976 along with his wife, Linda Fuller, and served in executive roles until 2005. When Fuller was awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom in 1996, Habitat was described as “the most successful continuous community service project in the history of the United States.”

Clarence Jordan (1912 – 1969) was a farmer, Greek New Testament scholar and the author of the famed *Cotton Patch Gospels*. In 1942, he founded Koinonia Farm, an interracial Christian farming community near Americus, Georgia, where members worked together for the common good and all persons were treated equally. He is regarded as the spiritual father of Habitat for Humanity and Habitat’s operational headquarters in Americus now bears his name.


