TRUTH: Habitat homeowners pay an affordable zero-percent APR mortgage. Habitat is a hand-up, not a hand-out.

MYTH: Habitat homes are poor quality houses.

TRUTH: Habitat homes are built to last lifetimes. The homes are inspected by professionals and consistently receive high energy efficient ratings.

MYTH: Habitat is funded by the government.

TRUTH: Habitat for Humanity of Evansville is funded primarily through donor support. Additionally, Fund for Humanity (homeowners' mortgage payments) and the Habitat ReStore provide funding to build more homes in our area.

IMPACT

Revitalizing Our Community and Neighborhoods

- Built over 500 homes in Vanderburgh and Posey counties.
- Neighbors would like to see more Habitat homes in their community – to increase the value of their neighborhood, decrease crime, and enhance unity.
- Average yearly impact to the economy is \$2 million.

Strengthening Families

- Served over 550 adults and 770 children.
- The high school graduation rate among children living in Habitat homes exceeds the official graduation rates for local public schools.
- Habitat homeowners are less dependent on government assistance programs.
- 97% of Habitat homeowners save for the future.
