

habitat's future homeowner 6-month money management seminar

In January of 2016, Habitat for Humanity of Evansville hired Donna Milam as its Family Services Director. Donna has worked to expand and improve the Family Services Department, including updating policies and developing new curriculum. With the help of dedicated volunteers and committees, there has been a dramatic improvement in Habitat's ability to train future homeowners for success.

Habitat's 6-Month Money Management Seminar, a new course offering, focuses on budgeting, saving, management of resources and living intentionally. With one-on-one mentoring from a budget partner throughout this 6-month period and the first year of homeownership, each homeowner will be equipped with the skills and knowledge to become financially stable and maintain their home.

The Money Management Seminar is an important element of helping families grow stronger, more stable, and more self-reliant – in short, to transform their lives!

interfaith build for unity projects

In its second year, the Interfaith Advisory Council (IAC) will represent Evansville as one of the 14 participating affiliates around the country to participate in the Build for Unity initiative. The IAC will sponsor two Build for Unity projects: the 2016 Interfaith Build and the first-ever Millennial Build. The Millennial Build will seek to unify members of our community ages 18-36 and provide them with the opportunity to build a home alongside a future Habitat homeowner and fund an entire house.

rock the block

To kick off Habitat building in Jacobsville, we hosted Rock the Block, a block party celebrating all the revitalization efforts happening in the area. Thanks to our numerous community partners, we were able to host a housing resource fair where residents could obtain information about several community services and nonprofit organizations. Attendees enjoyed free picnic food, bounce houses and inflatables, carnival games, a Boom Squad, Inc. performance and cardboard house parade for the children. The Habitat celebrations included a groundbreaking and a wall raising. The day was capped off with the dedication of the first Habitat home in Jacobsville!



Habitat's first-ever signature fundraising event, Hard Hats and High Heels, was a one-of-a-kind event that brought people together on November 12, 2015, at the Evansville Country Club to help raise money to build homes for families in need of decent, affordable housing. Dressed to impress, the attendees had the opportunity to walk down a red carpet to an entertaining night filled with a silent and live auction, dinner and testimonials from children of Habitat homeowners.



In February 2016, a team of 12 from Evansville traveled to Guatemala to help build houses and smokeless stoves with Habitat for Humanity of Guatemala. Each day the team helped build the foundation for the home of future homeowner, William Batres. A rotating group of four would also complete a smokeless stove for an indigenous Mayan family each day.

For every house built locally, a portion of the donations go to building homes around the world in countries that lack fundraising programs and have a great need for housing. We currently tithe to Haiti and Jordan.




