"Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances" — Paul's words to the Thessalonians challenge us during these COVID times. Here at Habitat, we did our best to give thanks in all circumstances as FY2020 brought both achievements and challenges in abundance. And amidst the peaks and valleys, we remained joyful, prayerful and grateful throughout.

#### **Peaks To Celebrate**

- 18 families became owners of beautiful, safe and energy-efficient homes.
- 22 other families were approved for homeownership and able to gain sweat equity hours, complete the 6-Month Money Management Seminar and other homeownership preparation classes, and be slated for closing in FY2021.
- 13 families paid off their last mortgage payment and now own their homes free and clear.
- 389 volunteers worked on the construction site, helped in the office, mowed Habitat property, built yard barns, served on the board and committees, and planned events.

Several major initiatives began in FY2020 and will be celebrated in future annual reports, including St. Theresa Place, a 14-home subdivision on the site of the former St. Theresa Catholic Parish, and a first-ever annual giving campaign conducted by 25+ community volunteers.

#### **Valleys with Silver Linings**

- Safety concerns prohibited widespread community volunteering, a critical way to acquaint the next generation with Habitat. Core Crew members responded heroically when restrictions were lifted, subcontractors filled in when needed (and were paid through a grant from the local COVID-19 Response Fund) and plans were made for the construction department of EVSC's Southern Indiana Career and Technical Center to build a house in FY2021.
- We missed our traditional home dedications the high point of the Habitat experience. But home dedication parades, outdoor dedications and even "Zoom closings" became the new normal. We were able to close on 5 homes between March 2020 - when the pandemic first struck - and the end of FY2020.
- Although COVID hit many families hard, only 9 percent (27 of 307 active mortgages) applied for forbearance, the opportunity to temporarily postpone mortgage payments and place those payments on the back end of their mortgage.
- As countless businesses and organizations discovered during COVID times, any existing structural weaknesses were exacerbated by the pandemic. In Habitat's case, the ability to work from home, to hold virtual meetings and to provide distance learning for homeowners simply did not exist. A generous supporter changed all that - providing laptops and the technology infrastructure so we could adapt, innovate and keep moving forward.

Yes, FY2020 has been challenging. But what makes us human is our ability to endure, to change and to grow. Thank you to all those whose names and faces are recorded in this annual report. Your partnership has helped us be grateful for both peaks and valleys and helped all of us "rejoice always."

#### 100 Homes with 100 Families

Habitat's 2019–2023 strategic plan, provides the framework to guide Habitat's efforts to increase homeownership rates and build family stability in the Glenwood, Tepe Park and Jacobsville neighborhoods. Building 20 homes each year for the next 5 years — a 33 per cent increase in annual house production — will be an important measure of our success.

Additionally, Habitat is focusing on cluster building (3 or more Habitat homes on a single block) to raise property values and revitalize neighborhoods while continuing to prepare future homeowners for success through its 6-Month Money Management Seminar and other required and optional classes. A first-ever annual fund campaign will encourage donors to support Habitat with yearly contributions, with an overall fundraising target of \$10 million in gifts in the next 5 years.





Clarence Jordan (1912 – 1969) was a farmer, Greek New Testament scholar and the author of the famed Cotton Patch Gospels. In 1942, he founded Koinonia Farm, an interracial Christian farming community near Americus, Georgia, where members worked together for the common good and all persons were treated equally. He is regarded as the spiritual father of Habitat for Humanity and Habitat's operational headquarters in Americus now bears his name.
