

Each year when it's time for us to gather information for our Annual Report, I find myself overwhelmed with a resounding sense of **hope**. Through the struggles of recent years, it can be hard to maintain a sense of hopefulness, but seeing the year's photos of smiling families cutting the ribbon on their new homes and the statistics of lives and neighborhoods touched by Habitat's work laid out before me, that feeling of hope abounds. Hope because there are so very many people in our community who want to see our neighborhoods made safer. Hope because so very many offer their time, tools and talents out of the generosity of their spirit to help their fellow neighbor. Hope because more families have a safe, secure place to call home to one day pass down to their children.

FY2021 was a year of big projects and big **successes**.

- **16** more families moved into stable, durable homes they helped build from the ground up.
- **21** new families were accepted into our homeownership program and began working on "sweat equity."
- **14** families made their final mortgage payments and now own their home free and clear.
- **355** volunteers gave their valuable free time to helping Habitat families by working on construction sites, volunteering on committees, or assisting in our office.
- Our first **3** homes in St. Theresa Place were dedicated with Brooke, Keba and James.
- We maintained a **4-star** rating on Charity Navigator.
- We created a **women's leadership group** called Building Homes, Building Leaders in partnership with Old National Bank as part of Habitat's "Women Build."

We also set some big goals for the road ahead.

- We plan to finish St. Theresa Place and have **all 14 families moved in by early 2022**.
- We intend to have **600 homes built** in Vanderburgh and Posey counties by the end of 2023.
- We ranked as a **Top 40 Habitat affiliate** in terms of home production while maintaining a small staff and low administrative costs.
- We have started working with our first family who will build in **Northern Posey County!** Previously, all our Posey County homes have been in the southern portion of the county.
- We plan to build **39 beautiful new homes in the Jacobsville neighborhood** before moving into our next area of focus, Tepe Park.

And those are only a few of the milestones our organization completed in FY2021. It certainly wasn't a year without its challenges — particularly those arising from having to **limit all on-site volunteer opportunities** until the final weeks of the fiscal year as well as the rising costs of supplies that created a more than **12 percent increase** in the cost to build one of our homes. But as we reflect on FY2021, our hope and optimism for the futures of our families, our community and our organization remain bright. We could not do this important work without all those who supported us during this time, and for that, we thank you.


North Posey County – It has long been the mission of our organization to serve not just Evansville, but also the greater region by building in Vanderburgh and Posey Counties. However, with over a dozen homes completed in Mt. Vernon, we have not yet built in the northern portion of Posey County. A dedicated group of individuals have stepped up to the plate to help change this. Due to their passionate fundraising and community engagement efforts, which included a chicken dinner that raised \$30,000 in a single day with a matching gift from GAF, they have now raised enough to build the first home in Poseyville!

St. Theresa Place – In August of 2020, we broke ground on a new project: the St. Theresa Place subdivision. St. Theresa Place would become the home of 14 local hardworking families, and their homes would stand on the undoubtedly holy ground where St. Theresa Catholic Church and School stood in Evansville for decades. The first family moved into their home in June of 2021, and by early 2022, all 14 families will reside in this beautiful new development!







The Clarence Jordan Society

honors partners whose cumulative giving totals \$250,000 – \$499,999.

Clarence Jordan (1912 – 1969) was a farmer, Greek New Testament scholar and the author of the famed *Cotton Patch Gospels*. In 1942, he founded Koinonia Farm, an interracial Christian farming community near Americus, Georgia, where members worked together for the common good and all persons were treated equally. He is regarded as the spiritual father of Habitat for Humanity and Habitat’s operational headquarters in Americus now bears his name.


