A NOTE FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

"Care for the flock that God has entrusted to you. Watch over it willingly, not grudgingly – not for what you will get out of it, but because you are eager to serve God." – 1 Peter 5:2

As I reflect on the past year and the **27 families who received the keys to the homes they helped build**, I'm reminded that nothing we do at Habitat for Humanity of Evansville would be possible without God's blessing and the selfless sacrifices of so many caring individuals. Whether it's the financial support of our generous donors, the hard work of our Core Crew and volunteers, the guidance and wisdom of our amazing Board of Directors, the dedication and commitment of our wonderful staff, or the sheer determination of the future homeowners, we all play a role in this important work.

Fiscal Year 2022 was full of successes... along with a few challenges, but it was definitely a year worth celebrating!

- **27** families received the keys to their new homes.
- Once again Habitat for Humanity of Evansville was named a **top-producing affiliate**, and we ranked 12th in the nation among 1,075 Habitat affiliates in new home construction.
- **16** families made their final mortgage payment and officially own their home debt-free.
- Last year our work generated **over \$7 million** in economic impact.
- During the fiscal year, Habitat's building was concentrated in the Jacobsville Neighborhood, an area which has long suffered from disinvestment. The **78 new houses** that Habitat has built in Jacobsville since 2016 complement other major developments in the area such as the Complete Streets Improvement Project, the Deaconess Aquatic Center, the Forge on Main Workforce Housing Apartments, and multiple thriving businesses on North Main Street.
- **79** classes were offered during the year to current and future homeowners including the Six-Month Money Management Seminar, Stress Management, Basic Home Maintenance, Estate Planning, and more. These classes are taught by professionals in various fields who volunteer their time to help prepare Habitat families for successful homeownership.
- **915** volunteers committed their time and energy toward helping Habitat families by working on construction sites, serving on boards and committees, and helping in the office.
- Habitat maintained its **4-star Charity Navigator rating** which is a nationally recognized give-with-confidence stamp of approval.

While Jacobsville will remain a focus of ours for several years to come, we look forward to moving into the Tepe Park Neighborhood during the next fiscal year. We will collaborate with Community One in Tepe Park, much like what we did with the Dream Center in Jacobsville, to work toward fulfilling the goals of the resident-led "Love Your Neighborhood" plan. Your support will enable us to **build over 24 homes** in Tepe Park, representing more than a \$2 million investment which we know will have multiple spillover effects and help transform the area.

When I see the smiling faces of a homeowner's friends and loved ones at a home dedication or the tears of joy in the eyes of families when they receive the keys to their new homes, I remember that we all have a flock to care for and a job to do. With your help, I am confident we can continue to make the world a better place – one family, one block, one neighborhood, one community at a time. **Thank you for joyfully caring for your flock!**

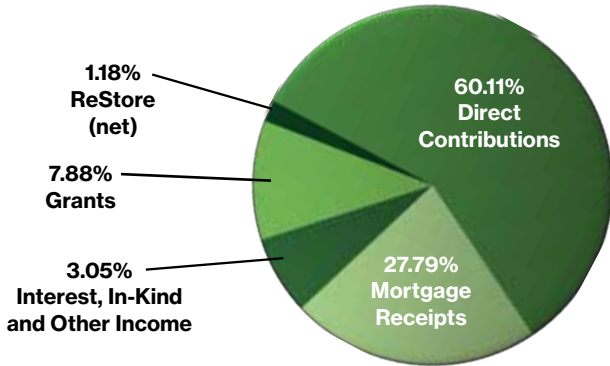

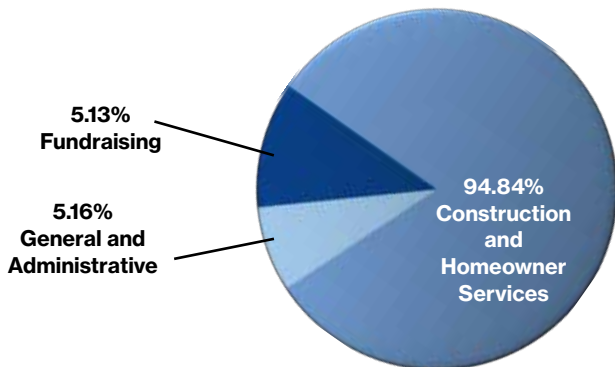

Building Homes and Health



Last year we celebrated our first home dedication from the Building Homes and Health program. Building Homes and Health is a collaborative project with Habitat for Humanity of Evansville, Deaconess, IU School of Medicine – Evansville, University of Southern Indiana, and University of Evansville. The program is funded by Deaconess, which has given \$250,000 to Habitat over five years to help three local families participating in the homeownership program have a safe, secure, and affordable home in the Jacobsville area. Students from the three universities – all future healthcare professionals – will help with the construction of the homes and receive a unique service-learning experience that will allow them to connect with members of the community.

Hard Hats and High Heels



Our 2022 Hard Hats and High Heels event was another tremendous success! Hard Hats and High Heels is Habitat for Humanity of Evansville's signature fundraising event, hosted by Habitat's Young Professionals of Evansville (HYPE). All funds raised at the event go towards the HYPE home build. This event raised over \$36,000 in 2022! Thank you to our generous sponsors for helping us put on such a great event!

Habitat for Humanity of Evansville joined together with the Evansville Otters and Eyewitness News for the annual Habitat Night at the Otters. The game featured giveaways, a half pot raffle, and the return of Habitat's "500 Voice Choir" singing the National Anthem and "Take Me Out to the Ballgame." The Evansville Otters have been a strong and valuable supporter of Habitat and our work in the Jacobsville area for many years. Players and staff have even participated in build days where they raised walls on a home, installed vinyl siding, and distributed water and ice cream to volunteers.



Walking for Dreams

On May 22, 2022, Habitat for Humanity of Evansville participated in its first Walking for Dreams event. People from all over the area gathered at the river front in Evansville to walk and support local non-profit organizations, including Habitat. The event, led by Paul and Holly Watzlavik and their family, raised over \$70,000 for Habitat and helped build more homes for local families. This year's event will take place on May 21 and if we can meet our fundraising goal of \$120,000, we can potentially receive an additional \$52,000 in matching funds.

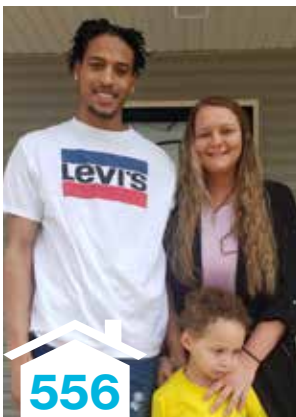
