

- We made great strides in our "Coming Home to Tepe Park" building initiative, which will see 24 new homes constructed in the Tepe Park Neighborhood and we hope to build more.
- 13 families made their final mortgage payments.
- 79 homeownership preparation classes were offered.
- We maintained our 4-star Charity Navigator rating, which is a nationally recognized give-with-confidence stamp of approval.

As we look forward to 2024, celebrating our 40th anniversary and dedicating our 600th home, I want to personally thank you for all you do for Habitat families and our community! Nothing we do at Habitat would be possible without your support. You are answering the call to use the gifts God has bestowed upon you to make our Habitat ministry and the world a better place. - Self-reliance to become an engaged member of society.







HABITAT HAPPENINGS



In April 2024, Habitat for Humanity of Evansville will celebrate its 40th anniversary. At this time, we will also dedicate our 600th home and

become only the 25th Habitat affiliate to reach that mark. This is a tremendous accomplishment not only for Habitat, but also for the entire community because it means there are 600 families whose lives have been changed because of the support of people like you! For our homeowners, a Habitat home is much more than walls and a roof. It is an opportunity to create a better future for themselves and their children and achieve dreams they never thought were possible. Thank you for helping so many local families have a safe, affordable and permanent place to call home!



In 2023, Habitat for Humanity of Evansville launched a new initiative to build 24 homes in the Tepe Park Neighborhood. Through your support, 7 homes have been dedicated and 17 more are currently being built! With the help of our other community partners like Community One, HOPE of Evansville, and Memorial Community Development Corporation, Tepe Park is continuing to grow and thrive. We will continue to build in Tepe Park throughout 2024 and hope to be a part of that neighborhood well into the future.



On May 19, 2024, Habitat for Humanity of Evansville will participate in our third Walking for Dreams! Walking for Dreams is an annual fundraising event led by Paul and Holly Watzlavik and their family that helps raise money for local non-profit organizations. The Watzlavik family, along with several other generous donors, also provide matching funds based on how much an organization raises. Thanks to your generosity and these matching funds, we raised over \$205,000 from last year's event! We hope you will support us again this year and help us raise even more money to build homes for local families in need.

Ascension St. Vincent Partnership



Each year, Catholics for Habitat raise money to fund a Habitat home for a local family. Last year, we were blessed to have Ascension St. Vincent partner with us and Catholics for Habitat to help build even more homes. Ascension St. Vincent has committed to donate \$40,000 per year to help fund a home for a local family and will also supply volunteers to help build the home. Alex Chang, President of Ascension St. Vincent Southern Region, says, "As the region's leader in Catholic healthcare, we are proud to support the work of Habitat for Humanity of Evansville and Catholics for Habitat. Safe housing is key to maintaining one's health." The first home as part of this new partnership with Ascension St. Vincent is already underway and will be dedicated later this year.

Becoming a Core Crew member doesn't require any construction experience and all skill levels are welcome.

The Clarence Jordan Society

Clarence Jordan (1912 – 1969) was a farmer, Greek New Testament scholar and the author of the famed *Cotton Patch Gospels*. In 1942, he founded Koinonia Farm, an interracial Christian farming community near Americus, Georgia, where members worked together for the common good and all persons were treated equally. He is regarded as the spiritual father of Habitat for Humanity and Habitat's operational headquarters in Americus now bears his name.
