As I reflect on this past year, I am filled with gratitude for all that God has accomplished through Habitat for Humanity of Evansville and through YOU – our faithful supporters, volunteers, and partners. Together, we have continued to build homes, hope, and community in powerful ways.

This year, we celebrated some incredible milestones:

- **22 families** received the keys to their new homes, creating safe and stable places for 22 adults and 40+ children.
- We opened our **new Volunteer Center** at 935 Maxwell Avenue – a space designed to bring volunteers together, provide training, and accelerate homebuilding efforts. This center allows us to **expand our capacity** to build year-round, even during inclement weather, by assembling wall panels and other components indoors.
- We continued our commitment to the **CHAIN neighborhood**, where families are not only moving into homes but building lasting relationships and a true sense of community.
- 725 volunteers and Core Crew Members gave thousands of hours to make these dreams possible. These volunteers saved Habitat over \$500,000 last year.
- Habitat for Humanity of Evansville was recognized as a **Top Producing Affiliate in the nation** for new home construction, out of more than 1,000 affiliates.
- We maintained our **4-star Charity Navigator rating** and **Platinum GuideStar rating**, ensuring donors can give with confidence.

These accomplishments remind me that when we use the gifts God has given us – whether teaching, serving, giving, or leading – we can achieve extraordinary things. Looking ahead, we remain focused on our strategic plan to serve 150 additional families by 2029, and with your continued generosity and God’s grace, I know we will reach that goal.

Thank you for being part of this mission. You are changing lives and building community every single day. Together, we build brighter futures.

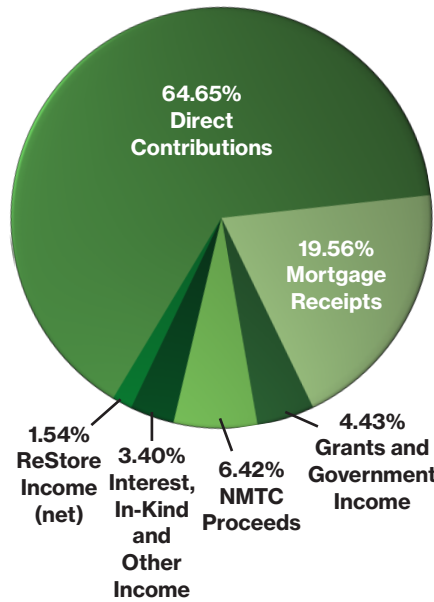

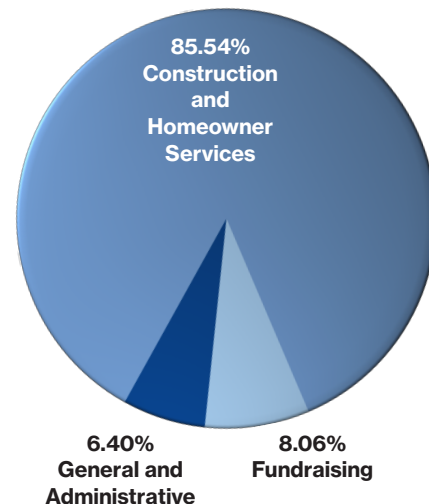

HABITAT HAPPENINGS

Opening of the Habitat for Humanity of Evansville Volunteer Center



In August of 2025, Habitat for Humanity of Evansville reached an important milestone in our “Together We Build, Together We Grow” strategic plan with the opening of the new Volunteer Center at 935 Maxwell Avenue. This space was created to honor the heart of our mission. It is a place where people come together to build homes, communities, and hope.

The Volunteer Center strengthens our ability to build year-round and expand affordable housing opportunities throughout the region while also allowing us to be better stewards of the resources entrusted to us. A recent community housing study showed a need for more than 4,000 additional housing units in the next five years. Evansville Mayor Stephanie Terry joined us at the ribbon cutting and shared her vision for addressing this challenge, saying, “It is an ambitious goal, but we can do big things here in Evansville.” Her leadership reflects what this facility represents. We are building toward a future where every family has a decent place to live.

Inside the new center, volunteers now have a safe and efficient space to construct wall panels and prepare materials with greater precision and consistency. By working indoors and using panelized construction methods, Habitat is able to use lumber and building materials more efficiently, reducing waste and maximizing every

donation. This improved process results in an average savings of \$4,500 per home, funds that can be reinvested directly into building more houses and serving more families. While the ability to work in all weather conditions is a benefit, the greatest impact comes from how much more effectively we can build.

Patrick Landry, Habitat’s Construction Director, shared how this strengthens our mission. “It will allow us to build faster and streamline our process. We will be able to build on bad weather days and create more homes for families in need.” By shifting many early construction tasks indoors, our team shortens build schedules, reduces material loss, and increases overall home production.

Longtime volunteer Greg Head has been building with Habitat since 2017 and says the center changes what is possible for volunteers. “One of the advantages here is that we can build year-round. For someone like me, it makes the work easier and safer. The different work stations help so much, and when we install the walls in the field, it takes less time.” Greg also shared how service strengthens him. “It gives you a purpose in life. We get energized. We stay healthy by working together. We have camaraderie with the people around us and we get to work side by side with the homeowner.”

The Volunteer Center is also home to a groundbreaking partnership with Ivy Tech Community College Evansville. Students will gain hands-on, work-based learning experiences in what Ivy Tech calls a living laboratory. Students will apply learning from fields like math, rigging, supply chain, logistics, and production processes. Future Habitat homeowners will earn college credit for completing Habitat’s six-month money management program. Students who face housing insecurity may also benefit from affordable homeownership opportunities through Habitat.

Ivy Tech Chancellor Daniela Vidal described the shared mission behind this collaboration. “This partnership brings together two powerful missions. Educating students and building affordable homes is a win for our students, for Habitat families, and for the entire Evansville community.”



The Volunteer Center also strengthens team building opportunities for local businesses, faith groups, and civic organizations. Volunteer days support mental health, physical wellbeing, and positive social connection. They also offer a direct way for people to help build stronger, healthier neighborhoods alongside Habitat homeowners.

Habitat for Humanity of Evansville believes in a world where everyone has a decent place to live. The opening of the Volunteer Center marks a new chapter in how we live out that vision. It is a joyful reminder that when people come together to serve, families thrive, communities strengthen, and hope grows.

Attainable Homeownership Tax Credit

The Attainable Homeownership Tax Credit (AHTC) offers Habitat for Humanity of Evansville supporters a meaningful way to amplify their impact. Indiana taxpayers – including individuals, couples, businesses, and corporations – can receive a 50% state tax credit on eligible contributions.

made to Habitat for Humanity of Indiana, with the option to designate those gifts specifically to Habitat Evansville. Eligible donations such as Cash, checks, credit cards, stocks, bonds, land/real estate, cryptocurrency, and larger in-kind gifts of building materials are eligible and can generate up to \$10,000 in tax credits per year, helping us build and preserve more safe, affordable homes for families in Vanderburgh and Posey counties. Donors simply note Habitat for Humanity of Evansville and their preferred build or fund on the required donor contribution form to ensure their gift directly supports local work.

Almost Home provides practical tools, financial coaching, and personal encouragement to help individuals and families reduce debt, build stability, and gain the confidence they need to take the next step toward owning a safe and affordable home.

Grounded in our mission to put God's love into action, Habitat's Almost Home program reflects our commitment to creating more pathways for families in Vanderburgh and Posey Counties to improve their shelter conditions. By investing in education and empowerment, we are helping more neighbors move closer to the moment when they can unlock the front door to a home of their own.
